



National Curfew Hours <i>(extended by 3 weeks)</i>	April 13 - May 04, 2021	<p>The island-wide curfew hours will remain at 8pm to 5am through to the morning of May 04, 2021. <i>Workplaces will no longer be required to close at noon on Fridays.</i></p>
	New Weekend Curfew	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Saturdays: April 17, 24 & May 01, 2021: Curfew will begin at 4pm ➤ Sundays: April 18, 25 & May 02, 2021: Curfew will begin at 2p.m.
Work From Home <i>(extended by 3 weeks)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The existing work from home directive in the public sector is extended until May 04, 2021. Only employees who work in critical services and cannot perform duties from home, should work from the office. ● Private Sector Entities are mandated to do a similar assessment and implement a suitable Work From Home Arrangement for employees, using the related 'mission critical' approach. ● Employees in the public and private sectors with comorbidities, physical or mental challenges, should apply to their employer, and the employer is obliged to allow them to work from home. ● Employees 60 years and older must work from home, until May 04, 2021. 	
Churches/ Worship Services <i>(Adjusted)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Effective April 14, 2021 until May 04, 2021, worship services will be permitted at places of worship, with a maximum of 30 persons, including officiating clergy, worshippers & IT personnel - as required. <i>(The number is increased from 12 persons)</i> ● The designated authorisation forms which were previously in place, will no longer be required. ● N.B.: <i>Curfew is at 4p.m. on Saturdays and 2p.m. on Sundays.</i> 	
Weddings <i>(Adjusted)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The cap on the number of persons permitted at a marriage ceremony remains at 15 persons, including officiant, until May 04, 2021. 	
Funerals and Burials <i>(Adjusted)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The existing restrictions on funerals and burials will continue from April 14, 2021 until May 04, 2021. ● Funeral Services are prohibited. ● Burials are permitted on Mondays to Fridays, only during the hours of 9a.m. and 4p.m. ● Only 10 mourners are allowed at burials, plus an additional 5 persons - comprising the officiating clergy, gravediggers and undertakers. ● Burials should be no longer than 30 minutes. ● Mass attendance is prohibited. 	
Gatherings <i>(Maintained)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Gatherings should not exceed ten (10) persons. For any such gathering, social distance of the minimum 6 feet must be maintained and masks must continue to be worn. 	





<p>Schools <i>(Extended)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No face-to-face instructions allowed in all primary and secondary schools, until May 04, 2021, including students who are sitting exams. • Exams may however take place at the physical location.
<p>Stay-at-Home Order <i>(Extended)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Persons 60 years and older must stay at home, except once per day for the essentials of life.
<p>Travelling to Jamaica <i>(Extended)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The existing protocols including the requirement for all travelers to present a negative COVID test conducted within three days of travel will continue to be in effect until June 30, 2021. • The pre-testing requirement does not mean that travellers do not need to quarantine for 14 days after arrival, regardless of the result being negative. The 14-day self quarantine period is applicable to all persons entering the island. • The existing ban on direct flights from the UK, Argentina, Brazil, Columbia, Chile, Paraguay and Peru will be extended until May 04, 2021. Travellers from these locations, coming through other countries will be required to test on arrival and await the test results in state quarantine at their own cost.
<p>Prohibition on Public Sector Events <i>(Extended)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Public Sector Entities (MDAs) are directed that NO SOCIAL EVENTS, CEREMONIES, etc. are to be held, except they are being held virtually.
<p>Closing time for some establishments <i>(Extended)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Zoos, Parks, Gyms, Attractions & Bars must close two hours before curfew hours daily until May 04, 2021..
<p>Beaches & Rivers <i>(Extended)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Beaches and rivers that are not under organised management and control will remain closed until May 04, 2021.
<p>Indoor Events and AGMs <i>(Extended)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Indoor cinemas, venues that hold artistic performances (concerts, parties, tailgate parties, round robins) must remain closed until May 04, 2021. • AGMs or EGMs of companies and general or special meetings of co-operative societies, friendly societies or industrial or provident societies are not to be held until May 04, 2021, unless the court has not authorised a fully virtual meeting.



Market & Places of Vending <i>(Extended)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Markets, places of vending, etc. are to close one hour prior to the commencement of curfew hours. They may open one hour after the curfew hours end in the mornings.
Amusement and Gaming <i>(Extended)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Amusement or gaming arcades (not licensed under the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act) must remain closed until May 04, 2021.
Public Transportation <i>(Extended)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Drivers and conductors are allowed one hour after the start and one hour before the end of curfew hours each day, for movement to and from home. No passengers are allowed to be transported during this time.All persons present in public transportation must wear a mask at all times.
