### Social and Physical Amenities

Housing	50% of houses were made from board, and 45% from block.	
	74.5% owned their houses and 9.7% rented	
	40% of respondents lived on family owned land while 31.7% owned the land.	
Utilities	32.4% of residents received public water piped into yard and 121.4% received	
	public water piped into dwelling.	
	90.3% of residents used electricity for lighting	
Communication	95.2% of residents have access to telephone services; of these households	
	99.3% used cellular phones and 0.7% used both cellular and land line phones.	
Sanitation	78.6% of households' garbage is picked up by truck.	
	Approximately 64.8% of households utilized pit latrine and 19.3% of all	
	households shared toilet facilities.
