Updated National Measures on COVID-19 Under  
the Disaster Risk Management Act: **November 16, 2021**

Revised National Curfew Hours (Nov. 18 - Dec. 10, 2021)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Period: November 18, 2021- December 10, 2021</b></li> <li>• <b>Everyday: 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.</b></li> <li>• <b>No "No-Movement" Days during this period</b></li> </ul>
Public Gathering Limit (Extended)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Public Gathering Limit remains at <b>10 persons</b>, with all mask wearing, temperature checks, sanitisation and physical distancing protocols in place.</li> </ul>
Worship Services (Revised upwards)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The <b>maximum number of persons</b> permitted to physically attend worship services is <b>100</b>, with all mask wearing, temperature checks, sanitisation and physical distancing protocols in place. This is subject to the availability of sufficient space for congregants to be 6 feet apart.</li> <li>• No crusades, conferences or conventions are permitted.</li> </ul>
Weddings (Revised upwards)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The limit on the number of persons permitted at a marriage ceremony is <b>100</b>, including officiant, until December 10, 2021, with all mask wearing, temperature checks, sanitisation and physical distancing protocols in place.</li> </ul>
Funerals and Burials (Revised upwards)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Funeral Services will continue to be allowed until December 10, 2021.</b></li> <li>• A <b>maximum of 20 persons</b> are allowed to attend <b>funerals and burials</b>, including the clergy may attend, with all mask wearing, temperature checks, sanitisation and physical distancing protocols in place.</li> <li>• <b>Burials</b> will continue to only be allowed from <b>Mondays to Fridays between 9a.m. and 4p.m. for a maximum of 30 minutes. No burials allowed on weekends.</b></li> </ul>
AGMs/EGMs (Revised upwards)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>AGMs or EGMs</b> of companies and general or special meetings of co-operative societies, friendly societies or industrial or provident societies may be held, with a <b>maximum of 100 persons</b> present, including technical support personnel until <b>December 10, 2021</b>. The observation of the other related mask wearing, sanitisation and physical distancing protocols must continue.</li> </ul>
Public Sector Events (Maintained)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Public Sector entities may have a <b>maximum of 50 persons at events.</b></li> <li>• The events are to be controlled and based on <b>"invitations only"</b>.</li> <li>• <b>Proof of Full Vaccination</b> is a requirement for attendance at any face-to-face public sector event.</li> </ul>

<b>Work From Home (Extended, with New Requirement regarding Vaccination Status)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The existing work from home directive in the public sector remains in effect until <b>December 10, 2021</b>.</li><li>• As a precursor to returning to work, Permanent Secretaries and Heads of Departments and Agencies must <b>put in place measures to ascertain the vaccination status of staff in the public sector entities in their charge, to facilitate risk assessment and planning.</b></li></ul>
<b>Entry/ Re-entry Protocols (Further Revised)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Restrictions on entry into Jamaica from previously “banned countries” have been lifted.</li><li>• The existing protocols including the requirement for all travelers to present a negative COVID-19 test conducted within three days of travel, will continue to be in effect until <b>December 10, 2021</b>. <b>Both PCR and Antigen tests are permissible.</b></li><li>• <b>Travellers who are not fully vaccinated</b> are required to observe <b>14 days quarantine</b>, upon arrival, regardless of the COVID-19 result being negative.</li><li>• <b>Fully Vaccinated travellers</b> who obtain a <b>negative PCR-Test result</b>, as their pre-travel test (within 72 hours of travel), <b>WILL NOT</b> be required to conduct another PCR-test on arrival in Jamaica, and will not be subject to self-quarantine.</li><li>• If the pre-travel/boarding negative result is from an <b>Antigen test</b>, travellers will be required to do <b>eight days self-quarantine</b>, upon arrival. If they conduct and present a <b>negative PCR Test (at their own expense, on arrival)</b>, the quarantine requirement would be waived.</li></ul>
