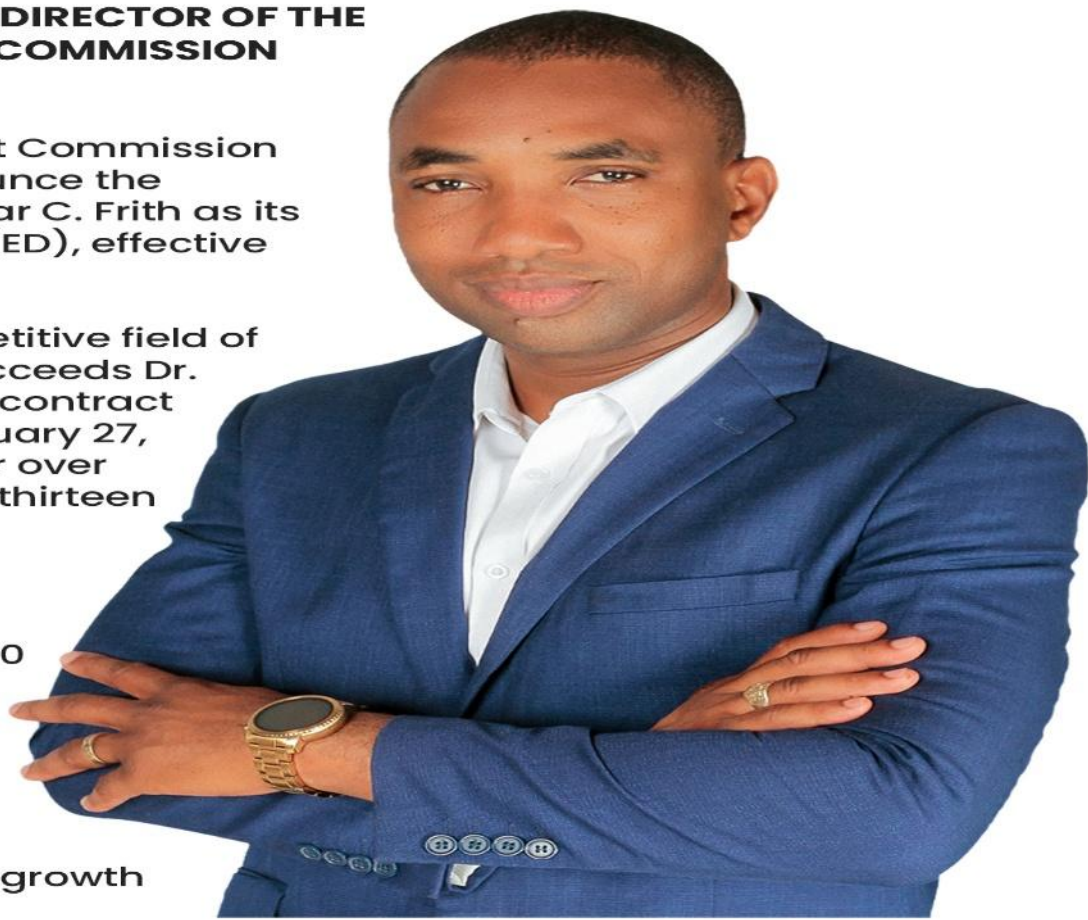


OMAR C. FRITH
